## Fall Landscaping

### Lawncare Tips as the Days get Shorter and Cooler.



Congratulations! The never-ending heat of summer is approaching its end and the hardest days of lawn care will be going with it. Here are some tips to keeping your lawn looking good over autumn and winter:

- Reduce your lawn irrigation. Try cutting back the frequency and or amount of water by about 25-50% in the cooler months. Less water is lost to evaporation and plants are not growing much during this time.
- Set your mower to a higher deck height setting and mow less often. Longer grass blades are able to make more energy with less light. This will promote better appearing grass and a stronger root system. Reduce mowing in fall to 1 time per week and 1-2 times per month in winter.
- Consider trimming overhead trees and branches at this time to allow more light in, especially limbs blocking the southern sky. If you have Crape Myrtles, trim them only in early spring. Expect more in that this spring 😊
